Please...No plastic bagging

<p><i>Please Recycle:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Number 1 or 2 plastic <p>TO PREPARE: Rinse bottles, throw away plastic caps and tops. Flatten if possible.</p>	<p><i>PLASTIC</i></p>	<p><i>Do not recycle:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plastic grocery bags ▪ Frozen food or meat trays ▪ Motor oil bottles ▪ Plastic containers other than bottles, regardless of symbol on the bottom (including margarine, yogurt, whipped topping and “baby wipes” tubs ▪ Polystyrene (Styrofoam) ▪ Six pack holders and rings
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ All food and beverage cans ✓ Empty aerosol cans ✓ Aluminum foil and aluminum baking tins <p>TO PREPARE: Rinse food cans, aluminum foil and baking tins to remove food particles. Throw away plastic caps from aerosol cans.</p>	<p><i>METAL</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Paint cans ▪ Scrap metal – please take to scrap dealers <p>Aerosol cans that contained hazardous waste or are not empty.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ All clear and colored glass food and beverage Bottles and jars <p>TO PREPARE: rinse bottles and throw away any caps.</p> <p>Handy Hint: It is not necessary to remove labels from recyclable items.</p>	<p><i>GLASS</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Dishes and drinking glass ▪ Light bulbs ▪ Window glass ▪ Auto glass ▪ Mirrors ▪ Pottery
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Milk and Juice cartons <p>TO PREPARE: Rinse. Flatten if possible</p>	<p><i>GABLE – TOP CONTAINERS</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Individual drink boxes and pouches
<p>All newspapers and inserts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Discarded mail and envelopes (with and without windows) ✓ All magazines and catalogs ✓ Gift, toy and tissue boxes ✓ Office and school papers (any colors) ✓ Corrugated (grooved) cardboard boxes ✓ Telephone books ✓ Shredded paper ✓ Mailing tubes ✓ Paper towel/toilet paper rolls <p>TO PREPARE: Boxes should be broken down and no longer than 3 ft in length. Do not bundle or tie with string or twine.</p>	<p><i>PAPER PRODUCTS AND CARDBOARD</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Boxes that held frozen food ▪ Corrugated cardboard with wax ▪ Pizza boxes ▪ Cereal, soda or beer boxes ▪ Paper towels ▪ Paper plates ▪ Hardcover and paperback books ▪ Non paper envelopes (including tyvek) ▪ Paper with crayon writing ▪ Packing paper that is padded or has a glossy finish ▪ Gift wrapping paper
